What is Indiana Choice Scholarship?

The Indiana Choice Scholarship is a state program created to offset tuition costs for qualified students.

Who is eligible?

Any K-8 student at a qualifying Choice Scholarship School who satisfies the household income requirements and has at least one eligibility track.

How can I apply?

Schedule a meeting with School Administration and bring your 2021 1040 form.

Where does the money come from?

Choice Scholarship dollars are your state tax dollars. Choice Scholarships don't "steal" money from the public school, we all pay taxes to support public schools. Choice Scholarships keep families from paying for education twice. Even if a child attends a Choice school, the public schools still get some funding .
