PreKindergarten

Mrs. Sisson 4-5 yr. old program

1 back pack large enough for a folder/ no messenger bags
1 plastic folder **without** fasteners to leave in backpack
1 plastic folder **with** fasteners
16-24 ct. crayons (write name on each crayon)
1 pkg white copy paper (boys)
2 boxes of washable chunky Crayola markers (girls)
1 pkg 5oz. cups
1 pkg of paper towel-select a size
1 pair of gym shoes to leave at school (inexpensive shoes will do)
Reusable water bottle with student's name to bring to school daily
Seasonal change of clothes in a gallon zip lock bag with students name to leave at school.
Family photo snap shot to leave at school

Preschool

Mrs. Harris 3-4 yr. old program
